


START AS YOU MEAN TO GO ON



OUR IMPACT

Since 2015, Edinburgh Food Social has shared a passion for local, sustainable and seasonal food through hands-on cookery classes, workshops, school projects and community meals, affecting thousands of people living in the top 10% of Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation.

In 2019, we launched our flagship *Good Food Apprenticeship* - an employability programme giving young people and school-leavers the skills, connections, and understanding to create a career for themselves in the food industry.

In 2020, we co-founded *Food for Good* as a response to the Coronavirus pandemic, providing individuals and communities with ready-to-heat food, becoming the first responders to a need for food in Edinburgh. We believe that everyone in Scotland deserves to have access to the great produce we have on our doorstep and the means to cook with it if they want to.
